

TERMS AND CONDITIONS (T&C) and PRIVACY POLICY

We at White Paper Summits LLC, take individual privacy seriously. This Privacy Policy Statement explains our policies and practices.

We respect your privacy and we will use reasonable endeavors:

- To implement computer, physical and procedural safeguards to reasonably protect the security and confidentiality of the personal data we collect;
- To limit the personal data collected to the minimum required to provide better service;
- To permit only properly trained, authorized employees to access personal data;
- Not to disclose your personal data to external parties unless you have agreed, we are required by law or any lawful request of any enforcement agencies or we have previously informed you.

Privacy Statement applies to Personal Data that you provide to White Paper Summits LLC or which is derived from the Personal Data as outlined below.

White Paper Summits LLC will determine in its sole discretion which posted content will be displayed on the overhead monitors at the Event Venue. By attending the event, you acknowledge and agree as follows:

(a) White Paper Summits LLC may edit and use the footage it captures at our events for marketing and promotional activities and for any other lawful purpose in the ordinary course of its business; and

(b) Due to the prevalence of mobile recording devices in today's world, White Paper Summits LLC disclaims all liability for the capture of your image in any multimedia format by other attendees at the event.

Information Collection

In order to provide better service to you and to fulfil the purposes set out in the next paragraph, we may collect certain information when you register with us or communicate with us. In the process, we may also collect personal information of individual contact persons of companies or their employees. Where notified, some of the requested information is mandatory and some you may provide voluntarily. If specific mandatory information is requested but not supplied, we may be unable to provide the requested service. We only retain personal data for so long as it is necessary for fulfilling the purposes set out in the next paragraph.

Why am I required to provide Personal Data?

As a general principle, your granting of any consent and your provision of any Personal Data hereunder is entirely voluntary; there are generally no detrimental effects on you if you choose not to consent or to provide Personal Data. However, there are circumstances in which we cannot take action without certain Personal Data, for example because this Personal Data is required to process your orders or provide you with access to the event or updates. In these cases, it will unfortunately

not be possible for us to provide you with what you request without the relevant Personal Data.

We may obtain information about you from our websites, when you call or email us or communicate with us through social media, or when you participate in an Event. An "Event" is an online gathering that includes registration before the Event begins, activities between the Event's start and end time, and after the Event's end time. We also may obtain information about you from business partners and other third parties and publicly available information.

The types of information we obtain may include:

- **Personal Information**, which is information that identifies you, such as your name, email address, address, phone number(s), and photographic image.
- **Demographic Information**, such as zip code, country, years of work experience, skills, industry, certifications, degrees, etc. We do this to help you connect with other event participants like sponsors and exhibitors.
- **Preference Information**, such as preferred time zone or whether to show a dialog on your next visit. We do this to personalize your experience on the Sites.

In addition, when you visit our Sites, we may collect certain information by automated means, such as cookies and web beacons, as described in more detail below. The information we may collect by automated means includes:

Use of information

The purposes for which information may be used by us include:

- Processing applications for exhibiting at or visiting our events
- Promoting and notifying you of our events
- In addition, photos and videos are taken at our events, which may feature attendees, speakers, sponsors or exhibitors. Where we have taken photos and videos at our events that feature you as an attendee, sponsor or exhibitor, to the extent permitted by applicable data protection laws, those photos and videos may be used for promotional purposes.
- Where we are hosting and managing a virtual event (and any third-party platform provider acting on our behalf) will use your personal information provided during the registration process to host and manage this digital event and for analyzing visitor interactions and traffic with a view to improving the event experience for visitors and provide you with a personalized experience.

You may choose not to receive promotional materials by simply emailing us.

We may use the information we obtain about you to:

- Create, manage and maintain your account on the Sites.
- Provide you with services that you request.
- Manage your participation in events hosted on the Sites, where you have signed up for such events and promotions.
- Maintain a record of the events in which you participate

- Enable you to interact with other event participants.
- Provide administrative notices or communications applicable to your use of the Sites.
- Respond to your questions and comments and provide customer support.
- Operate, evaluate and improve our business and the products and services we offer.
- Notify you from time to time about relevant products and services operated by White Paper Summits LLC

We may collect, compile, store, publish, promote, report, share or otherwise disclose or use any and all Aggregated Information, however, unless otherwise disclosed in this policy, we will transfer or disclose your Personal Information to a third party without your consent.

White Paper Summits LLC uses the personal data you provide in this registration for administering your participation in this event. White Paper Summits LLC may disclose your personal data to event participants but will do so solely in connection with the Event Attendee List and always in compliance with applicable data protection laws and our privacy principles. Except as described herein, White Paper Summits LLC will not disclose your personal data to any other third party without your consent except where required to do so by law. The Events organized by White Paper Summits LLC, which reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to limit or deny access to any entity or individual.

The Information We Share

When you create an account on the Sites, White Paper Summits LLC will collect and retain information about you, some of which is Personal Information. Please do not use another entity's or user's account without permission.

You are responsible for safeguarding the password that you use to access the Service and for any activities or actions under your password.

White Paper Summits LLC cannot and will not be liable for any loss or damage arising from your failure to comply with the above requirements. You must notify White Paper Summits LLC immediately upon becoming aware of any breach of security or unauthorized use of your account.

Security

Encryption technology is used on our secured web areas. We recommend that you do not divulge your User Login Name and Password to anyone. You are responsible for all activities that occur under your User Account and Password.

We cannot guarantee that the security measures we have in place to safeguard Personal Information will never be defeated or fail, or that those measures will always be sufficient or effective. To further protect yourself, do not share Event username and password with anyone.

GDPR
